






Figure 4. Transfer Characteristics






Figure 6. Saturation Voltage vs. Vge

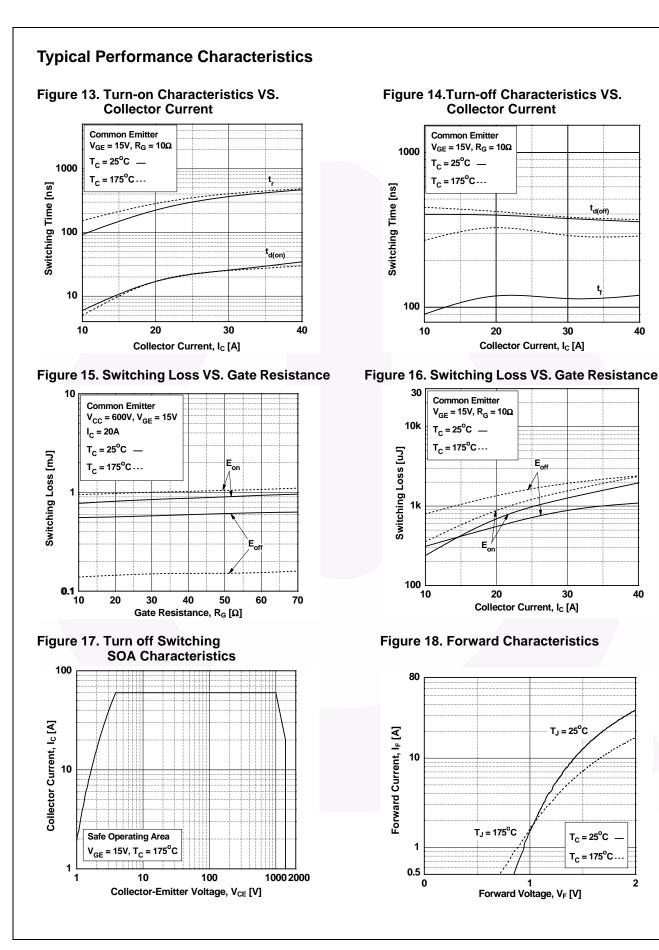

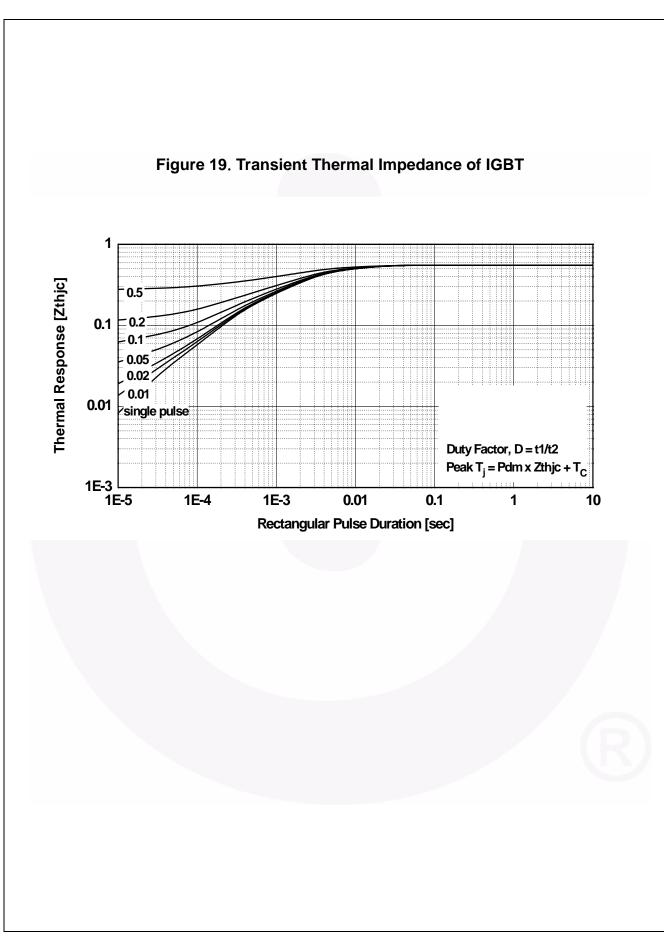


