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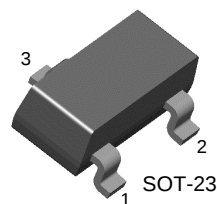

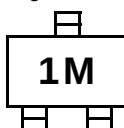

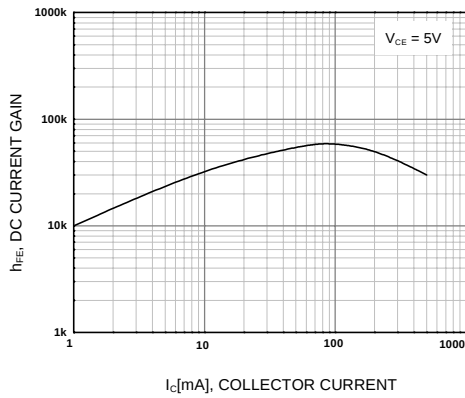


Figure 1. DC Current Gain

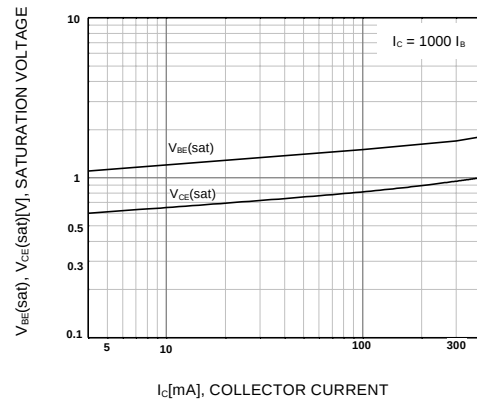


Figure 2. Base-Emitter Saturation Voltage
Collector-Emitter Saturation Voltage

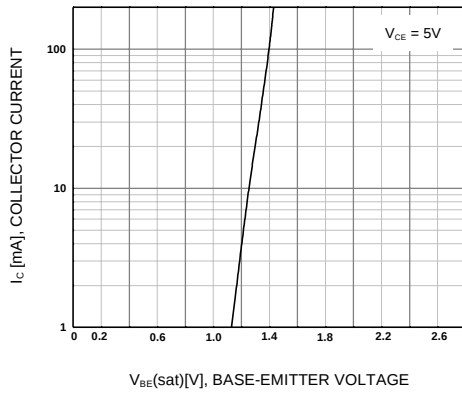


Figure 3. Base-Emitter On Voltage

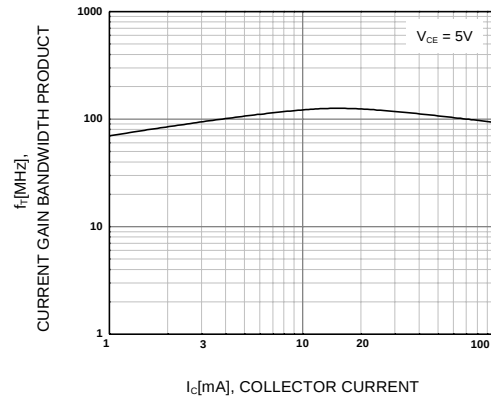
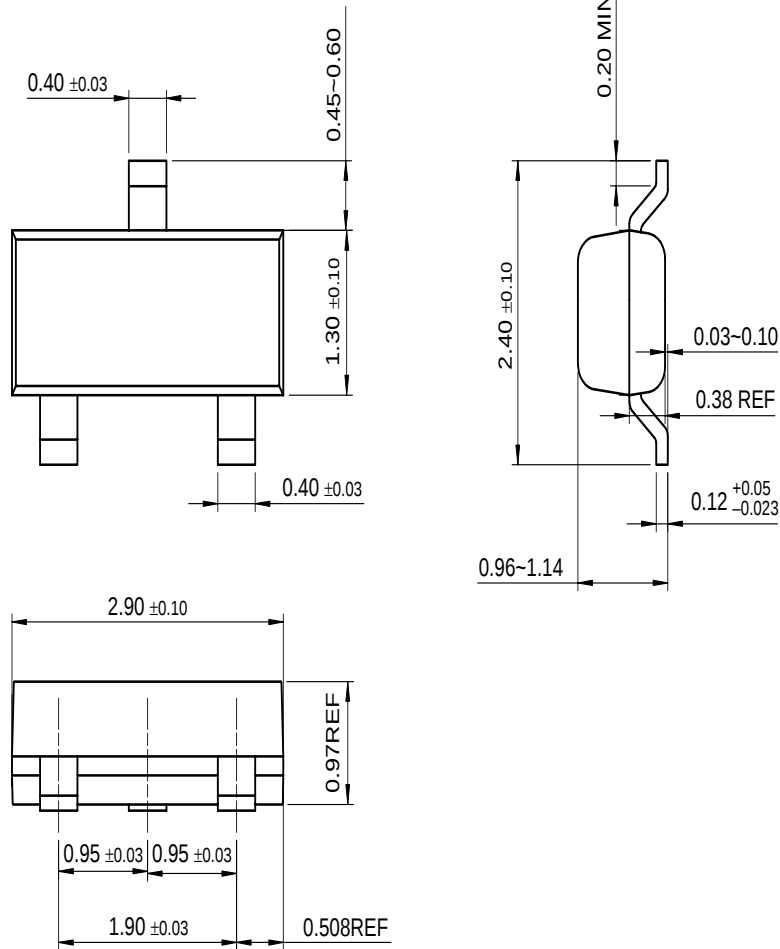


Figure 4. Current Gain Bandwidth Product
